2012 9th & 10th Grade All-State Audition Requirements

Scales:

ALL INSTRUMENTS will play **ONE** of the following major scales and arpeggios:
C, G, D, A, E, F, Bb, Eb, Ab.

All scales and arpeggios are to be MEMORIZED. Scales and arpeggios will be played in even eighth notes using separate bows. **Quarter note = 60-80**

Violin: G, A, C, D scales and arpeggios must be three octaves. All other scales and arpeggios must be two octaves.
Viola: C, D, F, G scales and arpeggios must be three octaves. All other scales and arpeggios must be two octaves.
Cello: C, D, F, G scales and arpeggios must be three octaves. All other scales and arpeggios must be two octaves.
Bass: E, F, G, A, Bb, C scales and arpeggios must be two octaves (no displacement). All other scales and arpeggios must be one octave.

Sight-Reading:

All students will be asked to sight read an eight measure original composition.

Viola:

Etude – Mazas, Etudes Speciales Opus 36, Book I; International Music Company
#18 Play m. 21 through m. 50 dotted quarter =44

Orch. excerpt – Brahms Symphony #2; Luck's Music Library
Movement I, mm. 204-224. quarter note = 112

Cello:

Etude – Joseph Merk, 20 Studies, Opus 11; International Music Company
#5 Play m. 36 through first note of m. 62 quarter note = 66


Excerpt Beethoven, Symphony No. 7; Luck's Music Library
Movement II, mm. 27-50 quarter note = 66

Bass:

Etude – Sturm, 110 Studies Op. 20 for String Bass, Vol. I; International Music Company
#38 Play through measure 29 quarter note = 104-120

Excerpt – Orchestral Excerpts for Bass (Zimmerman); Volume III, International Music Company
Page 17, Berlioz Hungarian March, Allegro marcato
Play measures 36 – 51. half note = 88
